A college or university is “peculiarly the ‘marketplace of ideas.’”
Healy v. James, 408 U.S. 169, 180 (1972).

It is axiomatic that the First Amendment protects speech, especially when the speech is offensive to some. See, e.g., Forsyth County v. Nationalist Movement, 505 U.S. 123, 134-35 (1992).

Speech cannot be “punished or banned, simply because it might offend a hostile mob” see Cohen v. California, 403 U.S. 15, 21 (1971)

Viewers who dislike a message have a responsibility to “avoid further bombardment of their sensibilities simply by averting their eyes”); Terminiello v. City of Chicago, 337 U.S. 1, 4 (1949).

Equipped with the full armor of God, great lawyers, and a truthful message we will win hearts, change minds, and send a message to this leftist institution that pro-life speech is alive and well. We will not be silenced!
