Here are the statistics about our campus outreach (spin-off groups included):

- Total number of universities visited – 242
- Total number of college age students reached – 6.9 million
- Total number of students trained in pro-life apologetics – 3510

If we are going to roll back the tide of the culture of death, we must be empowered to double our efforts in the next decade. In the next 10 years, the pro-life effort faces unparalleled challenges. YOUTH ATTITUDES ON ABORTION ARE CHANGING. According to a survey of college freshmen conducted recently by the University of California at Los Angeles, America's youth are more inclined to be pro-life than their parents. Also, Zogby International released a poll that showed many young adults now oppose abortion. Looking back, Zogby wrote that prior to the *Roe v. Wade* decision in 1973, nearly 86 percent of the students said abortion should be legalized. In 2002, a little more than 53 percent said abortion should be legal.

Interestingly, CBR has been showing aborted baby photos to hundreds of thousands of students in large outdoor displays since 1999. Could we have made a difference?

TO GET THE NEXT DECADE STARTED RIGHT, CBR has a very ambitious winter campus outreach and training schedule. In mid-February 2010, GAP will be displayed at the University of Florida, University of Central Florida (UCF), University of South Florida, and Florida Gulf Coast University. Also, our Pro-Life Institute (PLI) training program will teach over 300 students, including students at Ave Maria University located outside Naples. Roughly 120,000 Florida college students and faculty will be witnesses to the reality of abortion! DEMOGRAPHICALLY, FLORIDA IS AN IMPORTANT NATIONAL TARGET, but CBR's vision is global because abortion is global. Here are the facts according to the Guttmacher Institute:

- Annually, 42 million abortions are committed globally. One in five pregnancies worldwide ends in abortion.
- Most abortions occur in developing countries (35 million annually). Seven million occur in developed countries.
- Since 1997, 17 countries have liberalized their abortion laws. Three countries changed their laws to prohibit abortion.

These numbers are mind blowing! To win the abortion battle worldwide, CBR has established affiliates in Sweden, Canada, Hungary, Slovakia, Poland, Finland, Great Britain, South Africa, and Russia. CBR's international directors are motivated but still lack much of the training and resources necessary to wage an effective effort to win hearts and minds in their countries. With your help, that is all about to change. In February, 2010, several of our international directors and their staff members will travel to the U.S. to be trained as part of GAP and PLI in Florida.

Zain Reddiar, CBR's South African director, wrote recently, "The problem in South Africa is that people have the will but not the tools that will enable us to face pro-choice people who often present compelling arguments.
